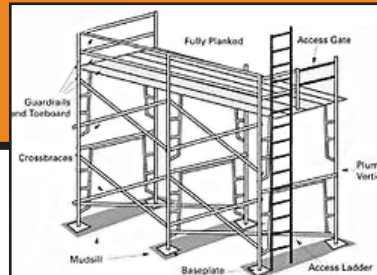
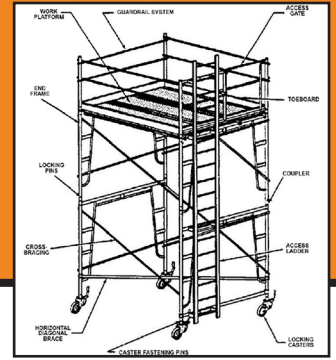


# SCAFFOLDING TRAINING
