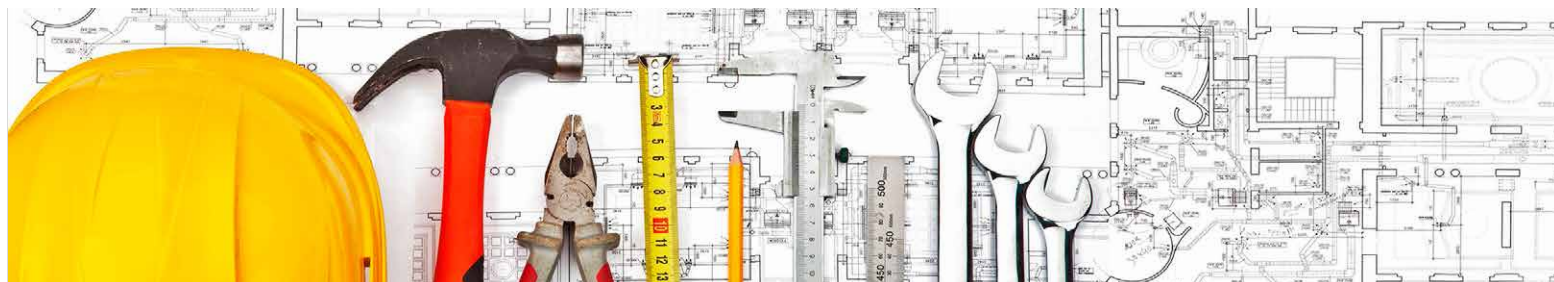

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CLEANING AND DISINFECTING REUSABLE RESPIRATORS

Frequently cleaning and disinfecting reusable respirators can play a part in keeping employees healthy. These respirators are touched often by the employees who use them and if they are not properly cleaned and disinfected, they could inadvertently cause an employee to become sick. In this lesson we will go over the types of reusable respirators, the hazards associated with wearing a dirty respirator, and recommended cleaning and disinfecting methods.

TYPES OF REUSABLE RESPIRATORS

How many types of reusable respirators are out there? While there are many manufacturers of elastomeric respirators, there are only two models available in halfmask and full-face. These two types can further be broken down by sub-categories. Which include tightfitting, loose-fitting, and self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA). Other subcategories consist of airpurifying or atmosphere-supplying. Air-purifying respirators are the kind that use

filters, cartridges, or canisters to help you breath in clean air while blocking a certain percentage of particulates. These filters, cartridges, and canisters require frequent changing in order for the respirator to properly protect the wearer. In contrast, atmosphere-supplying respirators supply you with clean air from an uncontaminated source. The type of respirator worn should match the hazard that you will be exposed to so if you have any questions about your particular respirator, please speak with your supervisor.

HAZARDS OF WEARING A DIRTY RESPIRATOR

Why is a cleaning a respirator so important? Did you know that continually wearing a dirty respirator can cause health issues such as dermatitis from dust, isocyanates, solvents, and other matter making contact with your skin?

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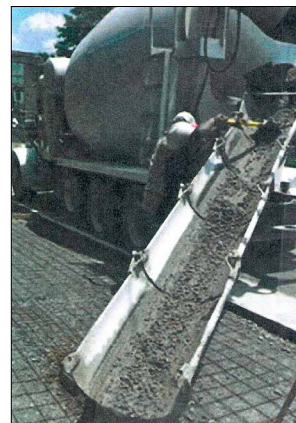
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CLEANING AND DISINFECTING REUSABLE RESPIRATORS

It is also a possibility that you may experience respiratory irritation or be exposed to illnesses such as colds, pneumonia, and bronchitis.

CLEANING YOUR RESPIRATOR

Cleaning and disinfecting your respirator can help minimize your chances of getting sick. Your respirator should be cleaned after each use and in accordance with manufacturer's instructions. However, you can use the following general procedures. • Put on either nitrile or vinyl gloves, in addition to any other required PPE by the manufacturer for the cleaning and disinfecting product; • Remove filters, cartridges, or canisters; • Do NOT attempt to clean disc filters or pads. • Disassemble the facepiece as necessary, depending on the model; • Inspect the facepiece per the manufacturer's instructions. Damaged or excessively worn components should be reported to your supervisor. Do NOT wear a facepiece with damaged or excessively worn components and replace them as necessary. • Wash facepiece with or in warm water with a mild or manufacturer-provided detergent or cleaner that does not exceed manufacturer-recommendations. Depending on the manufacturer, the maximum water temperature may be between 110 – 120 degrees Fahrenheit. • It is recommended that you not use cleaners containing lanolin, other oils, or solvents and strong detergents due to potential damage to your respirator. • Use a brush that will help facilitate the removal of dirt or other visible soil. When brushing make sure you use a brush that is recommended by the manufacturer. • And lastly rinse thoroughly with fresh warm water.

DISINFECTING YOUR RESPIRATOR

Keep in mind that cleaning is a separate process from disinfecting, so will you need to disinfect

your respirator after each cleaning. To disinfect your respirator, you should use a manufacturer-recommended disinfectant. However, you can disinfect your respirator by utilizing the following general steps: • Disinfect by soaking, wiping, or spraying the facepiece in accordance with the manufacturer-instructions. Be sure to allow the appropriate contact time for the product you are using.

- If you have chosen to soak your facepiece, make sure that you immerse the components in either a:
 - o Hypochlorite solution; or
 - o An aqueous solution of iodine; Note: Soaking times may vary between manufacturer's, though the time is usually one to two minutes. Do NOT exceed soak times.
- If you have chosen a spray method, you may use an alcohol solution with at least 70% alcohol.
- Rinse, wipe, or spray the facepiece thoroughly with fresh warm water after the allotted contact time has passed; and finally,
- Allow the components to air dry in a non-contaminated area. Remember to reassemble your respirator after all components have completely dried.

CONCLUSION

To review, of the two types of reusable respirators available be knowledgeable about what kind you use and how to keep it clean. You should clean and disinfect your respirator after each use in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, however, if you do not have the manufacturer's instructions this lesson will provide a good general procedure. Remember, responsibility for health in the workplace starts with you, so reduce your chances of becoming ill or contracting a disease by cleaning and sanitizing your respirator after each use.



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CONSTRUCTION LASER SAFETY

There are many variations of construction lasers, and each can be a time-saving device if used properly. Employees who use construction lasers at work are required to be properly trained and to apply all safe work practices in order to avoid damage or injury.

TYPES

There are many types of construction lasers, from measuring devices to leveling devices. Employees must know the difference between the lasers in order to choose the correct tool for the job.

- **Laser Distance Measure** - These tools use a laser beam to automatically measure distance – basically, this is the laser version of a tape measure.
- **Rotary Laser Level** - A rotary laser level is positioned in the center of a room or job site and emits a laser beam which rotates rapidly in order to create a steady line that is projected 360 degrees.
- **Line Laser Level** – These lasers project horizontal or vertical laser lines over a specified distance.
- **Plumb Laser** – The laser version of a plumb bob, this selfleveling tool is attached to a point of interest, and projects a perfectly plumb laser line.
- **Pipe Laser** – Provides a solid line to ensure projects are plumb and aligned correctly.

REQUIREMENTS

OSHA requires that the following safety rules are met whenever a construction laser is in use:

- Only qualified employees are permitted to install, adjust, or operate laser equipment.
- Operators must be familiar with the class and strength of the specific laser they use.
- Employees must wear anti-laser eye protection when working in areas where potential exposure to direct or reflected laser light is greater than 0.005 watt (5 milliwatts).
- Areas in which lasers are used shall be posted with laser warning signs and labels.
- Beam shutters or caps must be utilized where available.
- Employees must turn the laser off any time laser transmission is not required or when the laser is left unattended for any period of time.

CONSTRUCTION LASER SAFETY

- The laser beam should never be directed at another person.
- When it is raining, snowing, dusty, or foggy, the operation of laser systems is prohibited.
- All laser equipment must bear a label to indicate maximum output.
- Employees are never to be exposed to light intensities above the following:
 - o Direct staring: 1 micro-watt per square centimeter;
 - o Incidental observing: 1 milliwatt per square centimeter;
 - o Diffused reflected light: 2 1/2 watts per square centimeter.

CONCLUSION

When all safety requirements are followed, lasers can be extremely helpful and time-saving devices with minimal risk for injury. In addition to following the safety requirements listed above, you must familiarize yourself with the specific model you will be using and the manufacturer's safety recommendations to ensure that you are using it correctly.

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PREVENTING FIRES AT WORKSITES

Construction sites are sometimes the perfect places for fires to start. When you step onto a construction site, common items you may see include wood, paper, hot work, gas-powered or electrically powered tools and equipment, cooking equipment, and so on. One or more of these items can contribute to the starting or the spreading of fire. Fires may also be started by people who break into construction sites. In this lesson, we will go over Fire Protection and Prevention Plans, common fire risks that are found on construction sites, site-security measures, ways you can prevent a fire from starting while on the job and what to do if a fire starts on the jobsite.

FIRE PROTECTION AND PREVENTION PLAN

Under the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), all employers are required to have a Fire Protection and Prevention Plan. No matter what their position is, every employee should become familiar with this plan. Plans should consist of:

- A list of all major fire hazards, including proper handling and storage procedures for hazardous materials, potential ignition sources and their controls, and the type of fire protection equipment necessary to control each major hazard;
- Procedures that cover:
 - o Controlling the accumulations of flammable and combustible materials; and
 - o The regular maintenance of safeguards that are installed on heat-producing equipment

to prevent the accidental ignition of combustible materials.

- And the names or job titles of employees in charge of:
 - o Maintenance of equipment to prevent or control sources of ignition or fires; and
 - o The control of fuel sources.

In addition to the Fire Protection and Prevention Plan, it is essential that all employees become familiar with their company's Emergency Action Plan if a fire or other emergency happens on the site. All sites should have emergency contact numbers posted in areas that employees can easily see when they need to contact the proper authorities.

COMMON FIRE RISKS

When you step onto a construction site, ways that fires start or spread may not be your first thought. You should know that some of the most fire risks include:

- Temporary heating equipment;
- Hot work;
- Temporary electrical wiring and lighting;
- Employees smoking;
- Build up of waste and debris;
- On-site cooking equipment;
- The storage of combustible chemicals and flammable liquids; and
- Arson.

SITE-SECURITY MEASURES

Along with fire risks, it is also important to secure the site against pedestrian traffic as well as theft of jobsite property like power tools and copper. Employers and employees should do all they can to help minimize the chances of the site being targeted for arson. Sites may be targeted due to:

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PREVENTING FIRES AT WORKSITES

Not only is there potential loss of property, but workers' lives as well. Like many hazards, the best method to avoid these outcomes is prevention. Pay attention to the following categories as we discuss different ways you can help prevent fires on the jobsite. The Fire Department and General Fire Safety Before and during the project managers, supervisors, and employees should:

- Have managers and supervisors go over the project with the local fire department. During this meeting, managers and supervisors can inform fire officials about any specific particulars about the site that could cause a fire, get advice on local fire regulations, and identify areas that will help the firefighters have easy access to the fire should they need to be called out to the site.
- Have areas with weeds or grass kept down during the construction process. Employees should also avoid parking in areas with weeds and grass, especially during heat waves, because hot engines can ignite dry vegetation.
- Make sure to inspect perimeter fencing daily or at the beginning of each shift for signs of damage or tampering. Damaged fences that look like they have been tampered with should be reported to your supervisor; this could be an indication of unauthorized access to the site.
- And, become knowledgeable about all fire alarm devices for your site, whether you have


an alarm system, telephone system, siren, and so on.

Fire Extinguishers and Other Fire Fighting Equipment

Construction sites can vary in size and working tasks, and consequently, fire extinguishers play a huge role in helping keep the site safe from out of control fires. While on site, managers, supervisors, and employees should adhere to these guidelines to help make sure there are enough fire extinguishers in place in if a fire starts:

- Assure that all locations have the appropriate number of fire extinguishers for the area. Under OSHA, a fire extinguisher that is rated no less than 2A (i.e. a fire extinguisher that is as effective as 2 ½ gallons of water) is provided for each 3,000 square feet. Traveling distance from any point of the 3,000 square feet should not exceed 100 feet. A fire extinguisher that is rated no less than 10B should be provided within 50 feet of areas that contain 5 gallons or more of flammable or combustible liquids or 5 pounds of flammable gas.
- Fire extinguishers should be inspected monthly and serviced annually by a person who is licensed or registered by the State Fire Marshal.
- If you spot a fire extinguisher that has had its pin pulled, has not had its monthly inspection, or has not had its annual servicing, report it to your supervisor and manager.

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PREVENTING FIRES AT WORKSITES

- Have a portable fire extinguisher close to all hot work activities. Those assigned to a fire watch should grab a fire extinguisher prior to going to the hot work area if they are not sure if the area where hot work is taking place has a fire extinguisher already available. Smoking - Perhaps one of the most easily preventable sources of fires is proper disposal of cigarettes. If your site has a designated smoking area, only smoke in that area and use all provided receptacles for cigarette remains. Make sure that you have completely extinguished your cigarette remains prior to leaving the smoking area. Do NOT toss butts onto the ground or into grassy areas because a fire could result if the butt has not been completely snuffed out. If your site has a no smoking policy, adhere to it.

Housekeeping

Did you know that good housekeeping isn't just about keeping walkways clear? Housekeeping and site cleanliness can also decrease the risk of fire outbreaks at work. To help with housekeeping, you should:

- Remember to throw trash and debris into their proper bins. For sites with trash or debris located outside of the building, it is advised that you use ones with closing lids to help reduce the chances of arson.
- Have a separate metal container for oily rags and keep that container away from areas with sparks or heat. This container should also have a cover to prevent the rags from igniting.
- All flammable and combustible liquids and gases should be stored in accordance with all applicable

local, state, and federal laws. For many sites, this will mean the use of a flammable liquid storage cabinet. Fire cabinets should meet all requirements per local, state, and federal laws.

CONSTRUCTION: PREVENTING FIRES AT WORKSITES

Wiring and Electrical Cords Many jobsites rely on temporary lighting and electrical cords to give light to the area and to power equipment. When working with temporary or permanent wiring and electrical cords, you should:

- Inspect all wires and cords at the beginning of each shift. Damaged wires should be reported to your supervisor and removed from service.
- In addition to the inspection of electrical cords, make sure you are using the correct size of cord for the piece of equipment or lighting.
- And, because improper wiring could cause a fire, make sure that you inspect areas where wiring is being installed.

CONCLUSION

In summary, fires at construction sites are preventable fires. To help minimize the chances of a fire occurring at your site, be sure to follow your company's Fire Protection and Prevention Plan and to speak with your supervisor if you are concerned about a potential fire risk. Keep in mind that some fires on construction sites are caused by unauthorized access to the site, so be vigilant about security on the jobsite and notify your supervisor if you observe any suspicious activity. And remember, fire prevention is a team effort, so do your part by being aware of fire safe practices.
