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Special Alert: OSHA's Vaccine order is adopted for large employers!

Many private employers have been waiting for updated guidelines regarding the federal vaccine mandate that President Biden announced in September, and it is finally here! If your company has 100 or more employees, it's time to get ready for some big workplace changes and policy revisions. OSHA's COVID-19 Emergency Temporary Standard (ETS) is officially published, so let's review some of the highlights. NOTE: A federal appeals court issued a temporary stay on enforcing this rule on November 6th (you can read more about the <u>update here</u>). It is unclear what will happen next but covered employers are advised to prepare to comply with the ETS. In addition, we expect CalOSHA to update its ETS for the new year - never a dull moment in California!

When are the Deadlines?

For most of the ETS provisions, compliance is required by December 5, 2021! The only exception is the vaccination or COVID-19 testing requirement, which takes effect on January 4, 2022.

The complete ETS can be found <u>HERE</u> if you would like to review it in all of its glory. It is over 400 pages, so to keep it easy, we have summarized the key points for you.

Who is Covered & Excluded Under the Emergency Temporary Standard?

The ETS applies to private employers with 100 or more employees corporate-wide. Even if your organization has 250 employees but only 50 in California, your organization is a covered employer under the ETS. Excluded from the regulation are federal contractors and subcontractors, as well as healthcare employers, as they are subject to their own standards.

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Some specific employees may be excluded from this standard, even if you have at least 100 employees. For instance, the ETS does not apply to employees who are:

not reporting to a workplace where coworkers or customers are present; or

working from home; or

working exclusively outdoors.

What are the Policy Changes Required for Employers?

All employers with 100 or more employees must establish a written policy concerning vaccination and testing requirements on or before December 5, 2021. These employers must choose whether to enforce a Mandatory Vaccination or a COVID-19 Testing policy.

Two policy options:

Establish, implement, and enforce a written mandatory vaccination policy for all new and existing employees to

be vaccinated by January 4, 2022, subject to exceptions for reasonable accommodations (i.e., disability/medical conditions or sincerely held religious beliefs); OR


Establish, implement and enforce a written COVID-19 testing policy requiring those who are not fully vaccinated to be subject to weekly COVID testing requirements starting January 4, 2022. In this case, unvaccinated employees are also required to wear face coverings when indoors and in vehicles with others, subject to limited exceptions.

Documentation Requirements

Regardless of which option you choose, starting December 5, 2021, covered employers must:

Determine the vaccination status of each employee, and

Retain documentary records, and

Maintain a roster of employees' vaccination status.

Specific rules apply regarding what "*proof*" is acceptable. Remember that vaccination records must be treated as confidential medical records, and kept separate from employees' personnel files.

What Will this Cost the Employer?

The employer is not required to pay for weekly COVID-19 testing under the OSHA's ETS. However, OSHA's ETS provides that there may be a requirement to pay for COVID-19 testing under other state/local laws, or pursuant to a collective bargaining agreement. For California employers, it is likely that COVID-19 testing costs will be considered a "business-related" expense, meaning the employer is required to pay for it.

We do know that employers are required to provide employees with up to 4 hours of paid time per vaccine dose (which includes travel time), if they decide to get the vaccine. If you are in the LA area, you know that there is already a similar provision for time off to get the jab.

Employers are also required to provide a "reasonable" amount of paid sick leave to recover from any vaccination side effects. OSHA's FAQs state it will presume employers who provide for up to two days of paid sick leave per primary vaccination dose for side effects would be in compliance with the requirement. Luckily, the ETS provides that this can be in the form of accrued paid sick leave already available; however, if an employee has already exhausted all accrued sick leave benefits, the employer is still on the hook to cover this cost. California employers should proceed with caution when requiring use of mandatory paid sick leave.

Note: The ETS states that all tests must be FDA approved and cannot be both self-administered and self-read, unless observed by the employer or a healthcare provider.

Other Considerations for California Employers?

Keep in mind that California is required to follow OSHA's ETS, but the state agency (Cal/OSHA) is required to adopt an equal or more stringent standard, so stay tuned

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

The deadline of December 5th for most requirements is fast approaching! We have rounded up state and federal COVID resources on our website and you can access all of



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Deadline for Employers of 5+ Employees

Requirement to have employee retirement plan in place by 7/1/2022 or enroll in Cal Savers.

Even though the plan has to be in place by July 1st, many employers prefer to have the plan start January 1st for administrative simplicity since contribution limits are for calendar year.

CalSavers requires employers with 5 or more employees to auto-enroll those age 18 or older after 30 days of employment.

Penalties will be assessed for non-compliance.

Thanksgiving & Holiday Pay FAQs + A holiday poll

November is upon us, which means the holiday season is fast approaching. This is the time of year when our hotlines receive a lot of calls from employers asking about time off and holiday pay. Read below for some of our most frequently asked holiday pay questions:

Are Employers Required to Provide Time Off to Employees on a Holiday?

No. However, note that companies with 5 or more employees are subject to state religious discrimination laws and may need to allow employees to take time off for religious observance.

Do I Have to Pay My Employees if My Business is Closed for a Holiday?

No. Federal law and most state laws, including California, do not require employers to pay employees if time off is granted for a holiday. Whether or not employees are paid for holidays is generally a matter of company policy. Employers need to be careful when it comes to exempt employees,

though—as a general rule, if an exempt employee performs any work during a workweek, they must be paid the full salary amount.

Do I Have to Pay My Employees Extra if They Work on a Holiday?

No. Extra compensation (above and beyond an employee's regular rate of pay) for work on holidays in California is a matter of company policy. Some companies pay employees at a special rate (such as time-and-a-half) for holiday shifts; however, an employee is only entitled to their regular rate of pay, plus any overtime. A company's paid holiday policy should always be communicated in their **employee** handbook.

Are Holiday Gifts or Bonus Checks Taxable?

Yes. Unfortunately, anything that equates to giving cash must be considered taxable income for the employee. This


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
includes gift cards, gift certificates and bonus checks. The value of all of these must be included in the employee's income and are subject to employment taxes. However, if the employer buys a gift that is not equivalent to cash and gives it to the employee, it is not included in the employee's income. For example, a \$20 box of Godiva chocolates given as a gift to the employees is not taxable income for the employee. However, if the employer gives Godiva gift certificates to employees, it should "technically speaking" be included as part of the employee's income.

What does the Fifth Circuit ruling mean for OSHA's ETS & employers?

A day after OSHA published its mandate-or-test Emergency Temporary Standard (ETS) applying to employers with 100 or more employees, discussed here, the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals issued a stay blocking the ETS from taking effect nationwide (at least for now). The federal court cited potential "grave statutory and constitutional issues," questioning whether OSHA had the authority to issue the mandate in the first place. Note that the decision is not yet final – the court will engage in further review of the case.

What Does This Mean for OSHA's ETS?


The fate of OSHA's ETS is uncertain. For now, OSHA is prohibited from enforcing its ETS against employers nationwide. This means that even if you are an employer who is not located in the Fifth Circuit, you are not required to comply with the ETS while the court's stay is in effect. However, there are a number of different outcomes that may follow. Due to a slew of cases filed in other circuits, it is most likely that all of the cases challenging the ETS will be heard before a multidistrict litigation panel, or even the United States Supreme Court.

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In theory, the Fifth Circuit could lift the stay and keep OSHA's ETS on its original timeline (i.e., vaccination or testing compliance by January 4, 2021), a court may find the ETS is lawful, but the compliance deadlines will be pushed out due to the stay in effect now, or a court will issue a final decision that the ETS violates the law, and employers wouldn't have to comply at all.

What Does This Mean for Employers Now?

Because of the uncertainty, it is recommended that employers familiarize themselves with the ETS requirements, and have draft policies ready to go in the event the stay is lifted at any moment. The written policy deadline under the ETS was originally set for December 5, 2021, so employers should keep working toward that date. Hopefully, there will be a final and unifying decision in the coming weeks!

November 5, 2021 CSLB #21-20 CSLB announces new fee schedule for 2022

The Contractors State License Board (CSLB), which is funded entirely by license fees, protects consumers and supports the California construction industry by licensing contractors, providing resources for licensees, enforcing contractor laws, and educating consumers on the importance of hiring licensed contractors.

Because of increased operating costs, the state legislature recently approved a CSLB fee increase effective on January 1, 2022. This is the first statutory fee increase since 2017. The fee increases are the result of a study performed by a private consultant to establish CSLB's actual cost of performing the services associated with the fees.

In addition to reorganizing CSLB's statutory fee schedule and adding one new fee to change a license business name, the following should be noted about the <u>legislative bill</u> that makes these changes:

- Initial license and renewal fees are now divided by entity type (sole owner, corporations, partnerships, joint ventures, and limited liability companies)
- The \$450 active license renewal fee for sole ownerships is NOT being increased in 2022.

The decision to raise fees is not made lightly and in recent years CSLB has taken multiple measures to reduce costs. Unfortunately, CSLB cannot further reduce the expenditures that support the licensing and enforcement programs without negatively affecting our ability to process applications in a timely manner and to quickly mediate or investigate consumer complaints.

This fee increase will ensure that CSLB continues to be effective in regulating the construction industry in California.











Capitol Connection Q&A for Contractors

As we recently honored military service on Veteran's Day I wanted to revisit the opportunity available for our service men and women in construction and as licensed contractors. As many return from Afghanistan to enter the civilian job market the construction industry may offer positions and opportunity based on their service. And a second reminder that CSLB fees are going up soon...

Q: I noticed on the application it asks if anyone shown on the application has served in the military. Does it benefit me at all to mark that I did?

A: Yes, the CSLB will grant expedited application processing to applicants who are currently or have previously served in the military. In order for you to take advantage of this, you must submit a DD214 form confirming your release.

Q: I was discharged from active military duty about 18 months ago and want to apply for a CA contractor license.

All my related experience was in the military service handling various types of construction. Do you know how the Contractors Board will evaluate this experience?

A: As we discussed, in many cases, veterans possess transferable skills to meet the minimum experience and training requirements for a state contractor license. The CSLB offers a Veterans Application Assistance Program for those who are transitioning from military service to civilian employment. This program offers priority services to veteran applicants by evaluating transferable military experience and training, as well as education. From our years of experience helping veterans with their contractor's licensing, it appears you have the required 4 years to qualify for the license exam.

Q: I am a disabled veteran who has worked under a licensed contractor for 15 years of my life. I am now ready to venture out into the realm of having my own contractor's license. He has a "B" (General Building) license and we do all types of remodels and upgrades. What are the main requirements and how quickly can this happen?

A: To obtain your own license you will need to document at least four years of fulltime work experience doing that type of work. You will need to take and pass the Trade and

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

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Law exams and you will also need to be fingerprinted. The process usually takes anywhere from two to three months, however the Military Veterans Application Assistance Program at the CSLB assists those who are transitioning from military service. They will usually expedite your application to process it ahead of others to issue your license in having served the country. Thanks for your service!


Effective October 1, 2021, the Contractors State License Board will not enforce or implement its July 27, 2021, decision related to solar energy storage systems and industry bulletins numbered CSLB 21-14 and CSLB 21-15 until resolution of a pending lawsuit. Therefore, for the time being, "C-46" Solar Contractors may still install BESS until further notice.

The 7 Types of air compressors and their applications

Air compressors come in a wide array of specifications. As a result, effective air compressor use hinges on choosing the right machine for the job. Here's a look at seven common types of compressors.

For Construction Pros

Air compressors are some of the most crucial tools in a construction or rental business. These machines power a vast range of other tools, from nailers to pneumatic wrenches to paint and air sprayers. However, not every type of compressor is ideal for every end-use.

Because compressed air is such a versatile resource, compressors come in a wide array of specifications. As a result, effective air compressor use hinges on choosing the right type of machine for the job. Here's a look at seven common types of compressors and their ideal applications.

1. Rotary Screw

Air compressors fall into two main categories based on how they operate: positive displacement and dynamic. Positive displacement options, like rotary screw compressors, provide a constant flow regardless of outlet pressure. In a rotary screw machine, this happens by a pair of screws rotating in opposite directions to compress air in a sealed chamber.

One of the biggest advantages of a rotary screw compressor is that it can operate continuously as long as you need it to. They're also highly durable, often outlasting other types by a couple of years or more. As a result, they're ideal for prolonged heavy-duty use, like powering jackhammers or sand-blasting operations.

The main downsides to rotary screw compressors are their price and maintenance needs. They're often more

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expensive than other positive displacement options and require more care, so smaller operations may want an alternative.

2. Reciprocating

Another positive displacement option is the reciprocating, or piston, compressor. As the name implies, these use pistons to compress and displace air within their chamber. These are among the most powerful compressors for home use, making them a popular choice.

While rotary screw compressors can produce more power overall, reciprocating options can generate a lot with low energy consumption. They're also more compact than rotary screw machines, making them better for shorter, more flexible jobs. This low energy consumption and portability make piston compressors an appropriate choice for powering hand tools.

However, these compressors produce more heat and noise than other displacement machines, so they're not ideal for extended continuous use. For many construction jobs, that's

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not an issue, but they may not be the right choice for heavier machinery.

3. Scroll

The third main type of positive displacement compressor is the scroll compressor. These machines use two circular scrolls, one that stands still and another that turns inside it to compress air. This design results in fewer moving parts and reduced vibrations, leading to improved longevity.

Scroll compressors produce the cleanest air according to ISO standards. As a result, construction jobs or companies that have to adhere to higher environmental standards may want to use these machines. They're also versatile, operating at various intensity levels.

While quiet and easy to maintain, scroll compressors don't produce the most power. Heavy-duty tools and machinery may require a different type of compressor, but more passive applications are ideal for these.

4. Centrifugal

Unlike the first three entries on this list, centrifugal compressors are dynamic. That means they draw air in from the outside rather than using a closed reserve of air. In

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a centrifugal machine, that happens thanks to a rotor called an impeller spinning inside a cylinder to force air inside.

Some centrifugal machines use multiple stages to increase pressure, delivering more power. Multi-stage compressors can deliver remarkable horsepower, making them ideal for powering heavier equipment. Like rotary screw compressors, these machines can also operate continuously, suiting them to longer jobs.

Centrifugal compressors are also highly affordable compared to similar-horsepower alternatives. However, their reliance on fast-moving parts makes them more prone to issues like stalling or choking.

5. Axial

Axial compressors are another type of dynamic machine. Instead of using an impeller, these use rows of fan blades within a shaft. As air passes through each row, its velocity gradually increases, leading to higher pressure.

These compressors are typically smaller and lighter than their centrifugal counterparts and operate at higher speeds. This lets them provide constant flow rates at high volumes, but often with less pressure than alternatives. You'll often find them in pumping applications, thanks to their consistency and energy efficiency.

Axial compressors are a key part of jet engine designs, but in construction, you'll find them in pumping or

electricity generation. Overall, though, these are rarer on construction sites, thanks to their high costs.

6. Oil-Flooded

Another way to divide compressor types is by their lubrication, which falls into two categories: oil-flooded and oil-free. Oil-flooded compressors, as their name suggests, have lubrication inside their inner workings. More specifically, they have closed, oil-lubricated compression chambers.

Rotary screw and reciprocating compressors often have oil-flooded designs. The constant presence of lubrication means that oil-flooded compressors are often more durable. However, they also run the risk of seeping lubrication, potentially contaminating the compressed air.

The FDA requires oil-free air in some industries, so construction teams adhering to higher cleanliness and safety standards should avoid oil-flooded compressors. For most low-power construction equipment, though, these are a safe and cost-effective choice.

7. Oil-Free

Oil-free air compressors, by contrast, don't have any oil in the compression chamber. Instead, they have built-in, lasting alternative lubrication on their moving parts. As a result, these can produce air without any traces of potentially hazardous oil.

Centrifugal compressors are typically oil-free, and some oil-free rotary screw and reciprocating compressors exist, too. These can be more expensive, but they'll produce cleaner air and often work at lower temperatures and noise levels. These advantages make them ideal for construction in busy areas or eco-friendly worksites. Oil-free compressors are also better-suited for continuous operation since they require less upkeep. Over time, though, they may need additional work to last as long.

Get the Right Kind of Air Compressor for the Job

Like any tool in construction, air compressor efficacy depends on matching the right type of machine to the job at hand. The right choice can speed up or cut costs on a project, while a mismatch may incur unnecessary expenses and delays.

Understanding the different types of compressors is key to making the right choice. When you know what your options are, you can make a more informed decision, leading to better outcomes and more successful projects.
