 - Any student pursuing a career in construction

Dear Scholarship Applicant:

Attached is an application for the North Coast Builders Exchange 2021 Scholarship Program. It contains more information about who is eligible to apply for scholarships, the information that must accompany your application, and the basis for scholarship awards.

A transcript is required for the application process. Certified Transcripts are preferred, so be sure to request them as soon as possible from your high school (or college, if appropriate). However, online grade reports are acceptable if you can not get certified copies. Please note: We recognize that this past year has created many challenges for students, and that many schools are running at diminished capacity so it may be difficult to obtain certified transcripts within the timeline. If you are having trouble obtaining your transcript, or have any other extenuating circumstances that may impact your application, please contact Robin Bartholow at robin@ncbeonline.com.

The NCBE scholarship committee - comprised of NCBE members and professional educators from the local community - will review all applications and make recommendations for scholarship awards. The NCBE board of directors will review all recommendations and announce the final scholarship award winners no later than Monday, June 7th. Scholarship winners will be notified by mail.

Eligibility

The program is open to (1) spouses, children or grandchildren of the owners, partners, officers or employees of an NCBE member, (2) Spouses, children and grandchildren of NCBE Construction Hall of Fame inductee's, or (3) anyone pursuing a career in construction (including, but not limited to, architecture, engineering, surveying, construction management, and the building trades). Application for scholarship funds will be made by students entering or continuing enrollment in a university, college, community college or trade school. Applicants must also meet the following GPA minimum requirements:

- **Graduating high school applicants** minimum GPA of 2.0 on high school transcripts.
- Currently enrolled college students minimum GPA of 2.0
- **Vocational/Trade school students** tuition reimbursement is also available for students enrolled in vocational trade schools and apprenticeship programs. Records of enrollment, grade reports, or similar records of progress should be included with applications.

Basis Of Award

Selection of recipients will be on an achievement or merit basis as determined by the application, transcripts (GPA) and leadership qualities. Scholarship monies will be distributed directly to the student upon receiving proof of enrollment.

Application deadline

Application to this scholarship program can be made by completing this form and returning it to the office of the North Coast Builders Exchange in care of the NCBE Scholarship Committee. Scholarship applications and transcripts, must be received in the NCBE office by Friday, April 9th, (An email or fax copy of the application will be accepted).
