Dear Scholarship Applicant,

North Coast Builders Exchange (NCBE) is pleased to announce that the application period for our 2023 Scholarship Program is now open. This is an amazing opportunity for students to receive financial aid and support for their academic pursuits.

To apply, please complete the application included in this packet and return it via email, mail, or in-person at our office with a copy of your transcripts no later than Friday, April 15, 2023 at 5:00pm. Official transcripts are preferred, so be sure to request them as soon as possible from your school. If you are unable to obtain official transcripts, online grade reports will be accepted.

The NCBE scholarship committee - comprised of NCBE members and professional educators from the local community - will review all applications and make recommendations for scholarship awards. The NCBE Board of Directors will review all recommendations and announce the final scholarship award winners no later than Monday, June 5, 2023. Scholarship winners will be notified by both email and mail.

Eligibility

Students entering or continuing enrollment in a university, college, community college or trade school are eligible to apply for the NCBE Scholarship Program.

The program is open to:

1. Anyone pursuing a career in construction (including, but not limited to, architecture, engineering, surveying, construction management, and the building trades)
2. Spouses, children or grandchildren of the owners, partners, officers or employees of an NCBE member.
3. Spouses, children, and grandchildren of NCBE Construction Hall of Fame inductees.

Applicants must also meet the following GPA minimum requirements:

- **Graduating high school applicants** - minimum GPA of 2.0 on high school transcripts.
- **Currently enrolled college students** - minimum GPA of 2.0 on college transcripts
- **Vocational/Trade school students** - Records of enrollment, grade reports, or similar records of progress should be included with applications.

Award Amounts

Scholarship awards range from \$300 to \$2,000 and are based on academic achievement, extracurricular and community involvement, and your career goals essay.

Application deadline

The deadline to submit your scholarship application and transcripts is Friday, April 14th at 5:00pm.
